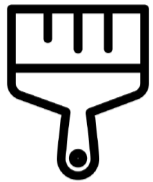

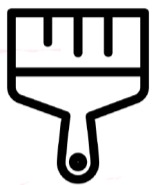

2ND INTERNATIONAL MEETING IN COPERTINO (1-2. December 2021)

The second international meeting of the QUARANTINART project took place in Italy in the lovely little town Copertino. Meeting was focusing mainly on the development of IO1 (Creativity Boost Guide) and IO2 (Play based, art filled, at home education for women course). We also discussed management and dissemination manners, raising issues, exploring new ideas and setting new tasks and deadlines. Quick overview of achieved and planned tasks also allow us to make some minor changes, influenced mainly by the COVID-19 crisis and our need to take into consideration possible challenges, which we will have to face in further development of the project.

LAUNCH OF THE QUARANTINART WEBSITE

Our QUARANTINART website was launched shortly after our 1st international meeting in Bratislava. Website is simplistic focusing mainly on the artistic aspects of the project. Website includes a home (landing) page, section about us where the project ideas are explained, including team and contact information. The section Course is prepared for the finalization of IO2 and its content. Last sessions about news and networking space will focus on the dissemination of the project results to the wider public. CREATIVITY BOOST GUIDE

Our first intellectual output will be available in January 2022. Objective is to demonstrate what are the barriers that limit women from expressing themselves in an artistic way and identify the most effective methods applied for engaging them with the arts. Examining the skills that are needed on behalf of women in the participating countries, so as to provide better quality services according to their needs even during emergency situations such as the pandemic- Covid 19 which affects all the learning activities of 2020. To design practical and valuable guides we interviewed 110 low skilled women and 67 art teachers/professionals in the art fields. We were asking them many questions and the results were quite interesting. If you are interested in what

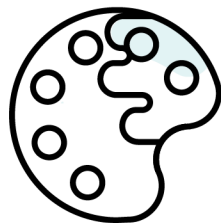
